

Camp S'more Rules

Basic Rules for Camp

- 1) The gate at the road must be kept closed at All times
- 2) All vehicles must be parked in the parking lot. Gear can be carried in or brought in on a wagon.
- 3) Youth are the responsibility of the Adults in charge and must have supervision at all times.
- 4) Fires in designated campfires area only. Campfire area must be kept clean and tidy.
- 5) No trees are to be cut down. Deadfall may be used for firewood.
- 6) Burn only appropriate wood or paper products, no plastics or other products that may give off toxic gases. Remember a lot of groups will use these fire pits for cooking food.
- 7) Toilets are outhouses. No Garbage, Plastic bags, or sticks are to be put down them.
- 8) Do not throw wood or Garbage into the River. River ice – Stay off.
- 9) Well water on site is not potable; Please bring your own water.
- 10) Practice NO TRACE CAMPING- Your group/people are responsible for removal of all items you brought to camp and the removal of garbage. Leave it better than you found it.
